DECISION ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE ACADEMY OF TECHNICAL AND ART APPLIED STUDIES BELGRADE

1. This decision establishes a higher education institution called: Academy of Technical and Art Applied Studies Belgrade (hereinafter: the Academy) with its headquarters in Belgrade, by changing by the status change of merging the School of Electrical and Computer Engineering of Applied Studies in Belgrade, 283 Vojvode Stepe St., (hereinafter: School of Electrical Engineering of Applied Studies), ., School of Applied Studies for Information and Communication Technologies in Belgrade, 16 Zdravka Celara St., (hereinafter: School of Applied Studies in Belgrade, 42 Milana Rakica St., (hereinafter: School of Civil Engineering), School of Railroad Transport of Applied Studies in Belgrade, 14 Zdravka Celara str. (hereinafter: School of Railroad Transport of Applied Studies), Textile School of Applied Studies for Design, Technology and Management in Belgrade, 24 Starine Novaka St. (hereinafter: Textile School of Applied Studies) and School of Fine and Applied Arts of Applied Studies in Belgrade, 2 Pante Srećkovića st. (hereinafter: School of Fine and Applied Arts of Applied Studies).

- 2. The seat of the Academy is in Belgrade.
- 3. The Academy is an independent higher education institution which, in performing its activities, unites educational, applied research and professional work, as components of a unique process of higher education. The Academy is an institution that performs the activity of higher education through the realization of basic, specialist and master applied studies, from several scientific and professional fields within the educational and scientific fields: Technical and technological sciences and Art.
- 4. The Academy integrates the functions of all organizational units and professional services in its composition and has the status of a legal entity with all rights and obligations in legal transactions and towards third parties.
- 5. The Academy has a governing body the council, a management body the president, professional bodies and the student parliament.

Determining the bodies, the procedure of election and dismissal, the number of members of collective bodies, competence and other issues related to the bodies of the Academy, are regulated by the statute of the Academy, in accordance with the law.

- 6. Funds for performing the activities of the Academy are provided from the budget of the Republic of Serbia and other sources of financing, in accordance with the law.
- 7. The governing body of the Academy is the Council.

Until the election and constitution of the Council of the Academy in accordance with the Law on Higher Education, the statute and general acts of the Academy, its tasks will be performed by the Provisional Council consisting of:

- 1) prof. dr Nenad Radovic, president;
- 2) prof. dr Sasa Mitic, member;
- 3) prof. dr Slavko Muzdeka, member;
- 4) prof. dr Rajko Miodragovic, member;
- 5) Žarko Otašević, B.Sc. philologist.

With the appointment of the Provisional Council, the mandate of the bodies School of Electrical Engineering of Applied Studies, School of Applied Studies for Information Technologies, School of Civil Engineering, School of Railroad Transport of Applied Studies, Textile School of Applied Studies and School of Fine and Applied Arts of Applied Studies ends.

- 8. Provisional Council of the Academy:
- 1) adopts the statute of the Academy within 30 days from the day this decision enters into force;
- 2) adopts the annual work programme of the Academy;
- 3) adopts general acts necessary for performing of the activities and functioning of the Academy, within 90 days from the day this decision enters into force;
- 4) adopts a plan for the reorganization of higher education units outside the headquarters;
- 5) conducts business analysis;
- 6) performs other tasks within the competence of the Council determined by the Law, the Statute and other general acts.
- 9. Prof. dr Bojan Babic is appointed for acting president of the Academy.

With the appointment of the acting president of the Academy, the mandate of the management bodies of School of Electrical Engineering of Applied Studies, School of Applied Studies for Information Technologies, School of Civil Engineering, School of Railroad Transport of Applied Studies, Textile School of Applied Studies and School of Fine and Applied Arts of Applied Studies ends.

The acting president of the Academy will perform the duties of the governing body of: School of Electrical Engineering of Applied Studies, School of Applied Studies for Information Technologies, School of Civil Engineering, School of Railroad Transport of Applied Studies, Textile School of Applied Studies and School of Fine and Applied Arts of Applied Studies, until the entry of the Academy in the court register.

- 10. The acting president submits a request for the issuance of a work permit within 60 days from the day of the adoption of the statute of the Academy.
- 11. The Council, the President and the professional bodies of the Academy and the Student Parliament will be elected, i.e. appointed, in accordance with the Law on Higher Education, the Statute and the general acts of the Academy, within six months from the day the Statute is adopted.

With the appointment of professional bodies and the student parliament of the Academy in accordance with the law, statute and general acts of the Academy, the mandate of the professional bodies and student parliaments of School of Electrical Engineering of Applied Studies, School of Applied Studies for Information Technologies, School of Civil Engineering, School of Railroad Transport of Applied Studies, Textile School of Applied Studies and School of Fine and Applied Arts of Applied Studies ends.

- 12. School of Electrical Engineering of Applied Studies, School of Applied Studies for Information Technologies, School of Civil Engineering, School of Railroad Transport of Applied Studies, Textile School of Applied Studies and School of Fine and Applied Arts of Applied Studies enrolled in study programmes ending with the 2019/2020 school year continue their studies in the enrolled study programmes according to the curriculum, conditions and rules of studies, in accordance with the law.
- 13. Until obtaining the work permit and enrolling the Academy in the court register School of Electrical Engineering of Applied Studies, School of Applied Studies for Information Technologies, School of Civil Engineering, School of Railroad Transport of Applied Studies, Textile School of Applied Studies and School of Fine and Applied Arts of Applied Studies will continue to conduct accredited study programmes, in accordance with a valid work permit.
- 14. Until obtaining the work permit and registration of the Academy in the court register, public documents will be issued and certified by the dry stamp of School of Electrical Engineering of Applied Studies, School of Applied Studies for Information Technologies, School of Civil Engineering, School of Railroad Transport of Applied Studies, Textile School of Applied Studies and School of Fine and Applied Arts of Applied Studies, and will be signed by the acting president of the Academy.
- 15. On the day of enrollment in the court register, the Academy takes over employees, property, rights and obligations, student registers and all other records School of Electrical Engineering of Applied Studies, School of Applied Studies for Information Technologies, School of Civil Engineering, School of Railroad Transport of Applied Studies, Textile School of Applied Studies and School of Fine and Applied Arts of Applied Studies.
- 16. This Decision shall enter into force on the eighth day from the day of its publication in "Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia".
